



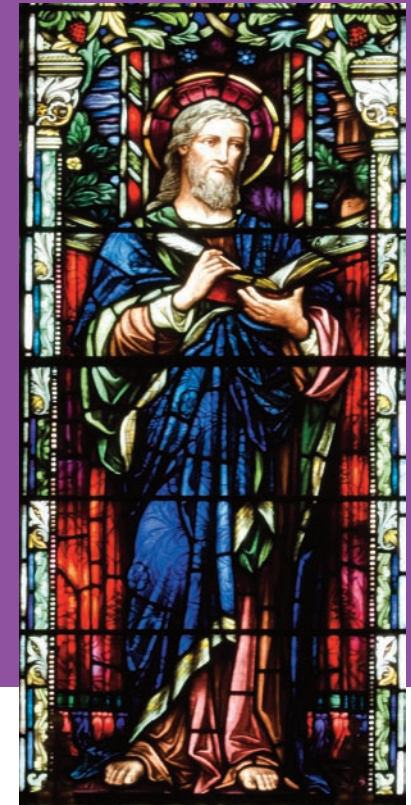

Planned Giving

All that we are comes from God

We are stewards of God's bounty. For a brief period, we are given time, energy, and resources. What we do with these gifts ultimately defines the character of our life and the depth of our spiritual understanding.

What is planned giving?

Planned giving is a way for anyone concerned with the wise use of his or her personal resources to make a considered choice about their ultimate disposition. Planned giving also establishes a way for donors to provide for family members while also remembering St. Luke's Church.



How are planned gifts made?

In general, planned gifts are made through:

- > A bequest in a will
- > A life income gift, such as a pooled income fund, a charitable gift annuity, or a charitable remainder trust
- > A gift of special assets, such as real estate, stock, life insurance, or retirement accounts

What is the Charles Eldredge Society?

The Charles Eldredge Society recognizes parishioners who have included St. Luke's Church in their estate plans. The society is named after Charles Eldridge, who played a prominent role in the founding and leadership of our church back in the 1830's.
