UPCOMING CHANGES TO SUNDAY MORNING YOUTH FAITH FORMATION

As we look ahead to the new year, we'll be making a few adjustments to our Sunday morning Youth Faith Formation program beginning January 11. These changes are rooted in some wonderful news. Our youngest Sunday School class is growing in leaps and bounds! It has been such a joy to see so many children learning, laughing, and building their faith together each week!

- Because of this exciting growth, and in order to best support all of our students, our 6–8 class will be discontinued due to low attendance. Students in this age group who are present and not serving elsewhere on a given Sunday are invited to help us in a younger classroom. As always, they are encouraged to worship with their families in church or serve as acolytes. We are also currently exploring new Youth Faith Formation options for this age group that would meet on a different day and/or time.
- Our elementary classes will be reorganized to better balance class sizes and learning environments:
 - 2nd–3rd Grade will meet in Room 9
 - 4th–5th Grade will continue to meet in Room 7
- These changes will allow us to make the most of our space while continuing to offer a positive, engaging experience for every child.

Classroom spaces will be refreshed over the school vacation break, and families will receive any additional details as we move into January. Thank you for being part of a community where our youngest members are thriving. We're so grateful for your continued support!
